VOTING PROCESS

(Paraan ng Pagboto)

Be sure to check your name in the list of voters that will be printed in the precinct where you will vote. It is the responsibility of the Board of Election Inspector to post the final list of voters in each precinct.

On the day of election, present your ID to the BEI in your assigned precinct. Upon verifying your identity, BEI will give you a ballot containing the list of candidates in various vacant elective positions.

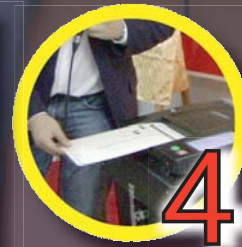

Using a marker, shade the entire circle corresponding to your choice of candidate.

After filling up the ballot, feed the form to the PCOS machine. The ballot will go straight to a transparent ballot box.

Pagka tapos bumoto i-feed ang nasagutang balota sa Precinct Count Optical Scan (PCOS) Machine. Ang balota ay didiretso sa transparent ballot box.

Reminders to Voters

1. Know your precinct number before the actual election.
 - ↳ Ask your local Comelec or go to Comelec website at www.comelec.gov.ph.
2. Prepare a Codigo.
 - ↳ Prepare a list of candidates of choice before going to your precinct to make the voting process faster.
3. Make a visual inspection of the ballot provided by the Board of Election Inspector (BEI).
 - ↳ Ballot must be free from any pen marks when provided by the BEI.

4. Use only the pen provided by the BEI in shading.
5. Fully-shade the circle of the candidate of choice.
6. Do not Over-Vote.
 - ↳ This will invalidate the contest (but not the whole ballot).
7. Do not fold the ballot.
8. Only one ballot per voter.
